

BASIC TREATMENT FOR ALL PATIENTS

For All Patients:

1. Scene Safety
2. Check Level of Consciousness
3. Call 911
4. Apply Personal Protective Equipment



Immediate Life-Threatening Conditions:

1. Open the Airway
2. Check for Breathing. If not breathing, provide 2 Rescue Breaths.
3. Begin CPR compressions. 30 compressions/2 breaths/5 cycles.
4. Apply an A.E.D. if available.
5. Continue CPR until help arrives or the person begins to breathe on their own.

Secondary Conditions (once the Patient is Breathing on Their Own)

1. Conduct a visual scan of the body. Also conduct a Head-to-Toe Survey.
2. Obtain Consent for Treatment.
3. Treat injuries from most serious to least.
4. If conscious, conduct a S.A.M.P.L.E. history.
5. When in doubt, always treat for Shock and Spinal injuries.
6. Do not move the person unless it is absolutely necessary.
7. Await the arrival of EMS.
