
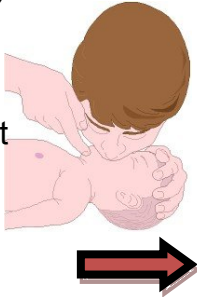
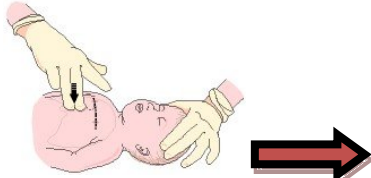


<i>INFANT CPR</i> 0-1 Year Old	How to Check	Corrective Actions
1. Check Responsiveness	<p>SCENE SAFETY! Shake and tap the person. Pinch the infant's hand or foot. If he/she does not respond...</p> 	Call 911 or other local emergency number.
2. Check Breathing	<p>Open the Airway (Head Tilt/Chin Lift). Look, listen and feel for breaths. If he/she is not breathing...</p> 	Cover the infant's nose and mouth with your mouth and attempt 2 shallow breaths. If they do not go in, re-adjust the head and try again. If the breaths go in, proceed to step 3. If they still do not go in, follow choking steps.
3. Begin CPR	<p>If the patient is not breathing on his/her own...</p> 	Place two fingers between the nipples and perform 30 chest compressions. Compress the chest ½ - 1 inches. Follow the compressions, give 2 breaths. After 5 cycles, repeat step 3.

Continue these steps until help arrives or the patient begins to breathe on his/her own.

An AED should not be used on anyone less than 1 year old.
